**ORDER APPROVING EMPLOYMENT OF GREENBERG TRAURIG, LLP
AS ATTORNEYS FOR THE DEBTORS**

This matter is before the Court on the Application of the Debtors to Employ Greenberg Traurig, LLP as attorneys for the Debtors (the "Application"). In the Application, the Debtors seek authority to employ Greenberg Traurig, LLP ("Greenberg") as attorneys for the Debtors, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§327 and 1107. Upon consideration of the Application and the accompanying affidavit of James R. Sacca in support thereof, and it appearing that Greenberg

does not hold or represent any interest adverse to the estates of the Debtors in the matters for which it is to be employed, and it further appearing that Greenberg's employment as attorneys for the Debtors is necessary and in the best interests of the Debtors' bankruptcy estates,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Application is **GRANTED**, and the employment of Greenberg as attorneys for the Debtors in the Debtors' Chapter 11 cases is hereby authorized and approved. The compensation to be paid to Greenberg for professional services rendered and reimbursement of expenses and other charges incurred by Greenberg in its capacity as attorneys for the Debtors shall be as determined by this Court upon proper application in accordance with 11 U.S.C. §§ 330 and 331 and such other procedures as may be established by order of this Court; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Greenberg may apply to the Court pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 503(c) for allowance of an administrative claim for services rendered to the pre-petition receiver appointed pursuant to Order of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Debtors may reimburse Greenberg for the filing fees in these cases and any adversary proceedings instituted herein, prior to said expenses being approved by the Court through the fee application process, but said expenses will be subject to review in fee application process and disgorgement if ordered by the Court; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that counsel for the Debtors is directed to serve a copy of the Application, the Affidavit and this Order on the CEP Service List and post it on www.wfperkinsforcep.com within three (3) days of the date of entry hereof, which shall constitute sufficient notice of the terms of this Order; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that counsel for the Debtors shall file a certificate of service with the Court evidencing compliance with the notice provisions of this Order.
